A total of 06 village meetings were held in Madagascar reaching a total of 284 people .Of these 196 (69.02) % were women and 88 (30.98) % male. The breakdown of meetings per province/region is

The table shows that the meetings in the last two months that have been conducted by Gender Links through its SADC Gender Protocol Alliance country partners continues to drive the village level workshops across the SADC region. Ordinary men and women were invited to learn more about the SADC Gender Protocol so that they can use the tool to claim their rights. From then on there is a multiplier effect where it is expected that those who attended initial meetings will train others on the same.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • .As per traditions men are given a certain status in society, how about it? • Is the work of SADC the same as with GL and with the crisis in Madagascar ? • What is the collaboration between GL and FPFE for the people in Ramena ? • What does the Council gain from the cooperation with Gender Links? • Gender equity does not work in our region for if men take care of children they are considered as defeated by their wife, so what should we do about that? 	<p>We are not to question or fight against traditions , but we try to leave stereotypes that are invented by the society.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SADC is one but GEndEr Links is an NGO that works hard to achieve the 28 targets in the protocol on gender and development. by 2015 together with the Alliance and FPFE. As for the crisis resolution the union of the countries in Southern Africa deals with it. • GL has been working with the local council for three years now, so if you would like to do so, the commune could speak to the officers in charge and Ramena could be part of the 'Centre of Excellence' • If the local council staff follow and understand the training GL conducts, there will be many changes in all development sectors , for both men and women can take responsibility. • What can be done is to get him involved in any development activity, the explanation can be given within the household, and it is the strategy to eradicate poverty, mutual assistance and collaboration between men and women.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why does the Alliance conduct such sensitization sessions within the community? • What is the link of this workshop with development ,yet it is the SA Region that devises it ? • -Why is the protocol amended since you said that it had 28 targets and Climate change and the others had to be added 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To inform about the reason why Alliance and GL are set up and also the SADC protocol on gender and development. • Madagascar was among the 15 countries that signed the SADC protocol, each of them agreed to implement this agreement on gender and development. And the Alliance Madagascar is the body that follows up and monitors the application of all the provisions. • It is right that there are 28 articles in the SADC protocol, yet it is believed that Climate change will tremendously affect human beings and the State members are convinced that a policy is required to mitigate the impact on the population , that's the reason why it has to be added.
